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## **Associate in Arts in General Studies with an Area of Emphasis**

The Associate in Arts in General Studies with an Area of Emphasis provides a broad, interdisciplinary curriculum for students interested in earning an associate degree and/or transferring to a four-year institution to continue their education. The program encourages students to explore the nature, perspectives, and common themes of disciplines within a selected area of emphasis.

Moorpark College currently offers four General Studies areas of emphasis. These degrees require the completion of a minimum of 60 semester units of degree-applicable coursework, including general education requirements and at least 18 semester units within the selected area of emphasis.
