Affiliated with the college Child Development Department, the Center serves as a practicum and observation site for members of the Moorpark College community. Part time morning and afternoon program options are available for student, staff, and community families, as well as full day, year round care for children ages 3 through 5. A Toddler program for children 2 and up is offered for part time care. Free and reduced tuition childcare is available for eligible students.
