Graphic design is the art, discipline, and profession of visual communication. By combining images, words, and ideas, graphic designers focus information toward an audience to achieve a desired goal. Graphic designers blend artistic talent, typography, and computer knowledge to create advertisements, brochures, logos, identity systems, packaging, catalogs, web pages, magazines, and books. Students work with industry-standard Adobe design software (Photoshop, InDesign, Illustrator, After Effects).
